1. That I am an employee of M/s-----

2. That I am entitled to the benefits of Majithia Wage Board recommendations  
in terms of the directions of the Supreme Court dated 7/2/2014 in WP ( C )  
No. 246/11.
3. That I am being paid the amount of Rs----- per month by  
the management whereas I am entitled for the amount of Rs-----  
-----in terms of the Majithia Wage Board recommendations  
w.e.f. 11/11/2011.
4. That I have been demanding the said entitlement from the management since  
the date of its application but the officials of the management has refused to  
release the same to me on one pretext or the other.
5. That the management has threatened me that if I demand the said benefits , I  
will be forced to leave the job.
6. That under its policy of harassment, the management has asked me to sign on  
pre typed formats under duress and has extracted my signatures on the same  
under the threat of my job. I do not subscribe to the same and I state that I  
want the benefits of the recommendations of Majithia Wage Board  
notification. My signatures on any such document be treated as cancelled and  
withdrawn as the same are contrary to my interests.
7. That the management has further transferred/ terminated/suspended me from  
my services w.e.f.-----just because I have demanded the benefits  
of Majithia Wage Board notification.
8. That the management has extracted the signatures of all the employees that  
they do not want the benefits of Majithia Wage Board notification under  
duress. The management has not implemented the said notification inside the  
establishment neither the management has complied with the directions of  
the Supreme Court dated 7/2/2014 in WP ( C ) No. 246/11.
